


The Ultimate iPad Pro Workflow for Street Photography



After returning from Hanoi in 2022, I realized that I needed to radically simplify my street photography workflow.

Why I Use the iPad Pro

- The iPad Pro is the greatest creative tool ever invented. It's light, fast, and easy to use.
- I walk around the room, culling photos, doodling, writing... it's like creating in motion.



Why It's Great for Artists

- Portability and power
- Direct touch interaction
- “You can create from anywhere, at any time.”




Feels Like the Future

- Split view: ChatGPT + iA Writer
- Dictate blog posts by walking
- “I just click the mic and talk out loud while walking.”



Better Than a Laptop

- • No hunching over
- • Instant-on, portable
- “It’s sleek, minimal, beautiful. This is what computing should be.”



Ricoh GR Setup

- GR III + GR IIIx
- High-contrast B&W JPEGs
- “I bake the look directly into the file so I don’t need to process anything.”



Importing Photos

- USB-C SD reader → Photos app
- View instantly
- “I simply use the Apple Photos app to view my JPEGs.”




Culling Intuitively

- 3x3 grid view
- Favorite what hits instantly
- “If it looks good small, it’s probably a keeper.”




Daily Backups

- Google Photos, AirDrop
- Stay organized
- “I back up photos and get them published ASAP.”



Creative Play with Procreate

- Remix photos, draw over them
- “Lately I’ve been enjoying remixing my photos... drawing, collaging, manipulating.”




What Is a Street Collage?

- Layering and recomposing photos
- Use brushes, blur, textures
- “It’s freeing. It’s fun. It feels like play.”




Writing on the iPad

- iA Writer app
- Markdown format
- “I write my blog posts in iA Writer and publish them directly.”



Publishing with WordPress

- Upload images
- Paste text, hit publish
- “I do everything from the iPad. No laptop.”




Making Slideshows

- Build in Keynote
- Sequence photos with fades
- “I screen record and talk over it in real time.”



Why Speed Matters

- Publish fast = no backlog
- “Photography should be fun. Not something that gets buried in a Lightroom catalog.”



Final Thoughts

- iPad Pro + Ricoh GR = Freedom
- “Everything is now fast, simple, and published. This is the easiest way to edit and publish your work.”
