





What Is Stream of Consciousness?

- Stream of consciousness means letting thoughts move freely — without filter or hesitation.
- Photography becomes a visual form of this flow. Each frame, a passing thought.
- *“Don’t think — feel.”*





Everything Is in Flux

- Everything changes — light, weather, emotion, self.
- Photography freezes what's already slipping away.
- The blooming fig tree reminds me that growth is constant — nothing stays still.
- *“Everything is changing. Weather. Seasons. Emotions.”*





Photograph Through the Gut

- Don't shoot with the rational mind.
- Shoot with instinct — that gravitational pull in your gut.
- Let your intuition move the camera before the brain interferes.
- *“Shoot with your heart, not your mind.”*



Courage = Heart

Thumos is the inner flame - the spirited energy that moves the heart to act with courage.

Conscious and Subconscious Seeing

- The conscious mind analyzes.
- The subconscious mind feels.
- Street photography happens between them — the bridge where instinct meets awareness.
- *“Maybe to evoke your stream of consciousness, you must shut off your mind.”*





Activate All Your Senses

- On the street, I open myself completely:
 - Sight — reflections, gestures, shadows.
 - Sound — footsteps, rain, music.
 - Touch — wind, air, vibration.
 - Smell — life and decay.
- Let the city talk to you — and answer with your shutter.
- *“Follow your curiosity. Follow your heart.”*





Movement Is Everything

- Photography thrives on motion.
- The body must stay alive, in rhythm with the world.
- Walking, reacting, flowing — movement is meditation.
- *“Snapshot your way through life; you move through the world outside of time.”*






Return to the Childlike State

- Photography is play.
- Curiosity is sacred.
- Approach the street as if seeing it for the first time.
- Forget rules, forget results — just explore.
- *“Creation is play. Snapshot your day.”*










Detach from Good or Bad

- There's no good photo, no bad photo — only moments of being alive.
- Each click of the shutter is a pulse of life-affirmation.
- Don't judge — just flow.
- *“Each click of the shutter is a moment of life-affirmation.”*





Imperfection as Honesty

- Blur, grain, crooked lines — they're real.
- They reveal your humanity.
- Don't aim for perfection. Aim for truth.
- *"The more unpredictable, the more true to the moment the photograph feels."*





Stay in the Stream of Becoming

- Photography is a journey without destination.
- Stay fluid. Stay open.
- Your next photograph is your best photograph.
- *“To be in flux is to be alive.”*





Paradise Is Within

- You don't have to travel far to find beauty.
- Paradise is already here — in your heart, in the rain, in the quiet moments.
- *“Paradise is within. It's in your heart.”*






Final Thought
